Resolution #25-25 FY 2026 – 2027 UPWP (Transportation Planning Budget)



FY 2026 Planning Budget

Resolution #25-25 highlights:

- Unified Planning Work Program activities are based on the Metropolitan Planning Regulations.
- The FY 2026 budget totals \$10,815,000
- BMC staff are supported with \$7,100,000
- Local jurisdiction activities are supported with \$480,000
- Consultant activities are supported with \$3,235,000





FY 2026 Planning Budget continued

- Included a 30-day public review between February 8 to March 9.
- A number of comments were received. The comments and proposed responses were reviewed and approved by the TC/BRTB and shared with those who commented.
- Comments touched on more funding for sidewalks, bike lanes, and public transit. Spend less on consultants and make budgets clearer. Transit over highways. Also a lengthy letter from BaltPOP covering a wide range of topics.

- Several jurisdictions sent "Additional Planning Studies" that will go into the final document.
- A minor adjustment to budget items with updated allocation figures.

FY 2026 DBE Goal

- Resolution #25-26
- MDOT is the designated state agency to certify DBE/MDE/WBE firms.
- The BRTB piggy-backs on the MDOT Secretary's Office process for goal setting on the basis of being located in the same or a substantially similar market as well as similar work.
- The FY 2026 DBE goal is proposed for 28.4 percent.
- Last reported billing period (ending Sept 30, 2024) resulted in 41.0% DBE participation.







Resolution #25-27 2025-2028 TIP Amendment: MDOT MTA Rural Transit Systems – Operating Assistance



Overview



 When MTA obligates a grant, we have to have the funds in the year of obligation





Rural Operating Assistance



Background

 This request supports operating funding in Carroll County and Baltimore County.

Benefit

This funding assists rural transit systems with operating funding.

Apportionment

 This amendment will add approximately \$783K in 5311 funds and approximately \$783K in local and state match.

AMENDMENT PURPOSE

- Add Project FY 2025-2028 TIP
 - Project was originally programmed via an amendment to the FY 2022-2026 TIP.
 - FY 2023: \$580K Engineering (\$464K Federal, \$116K County)
 - FY 2024: \$905K Construction (\$724K Federal, \$181K County)
 - Amendment to reflect balance of Costs Remaining
 - FY 2025: \$231K Engineering (\$185K Federal, \$46K Local)
 - FY 2025: \$1M Construction (100% Federally Funded IIJA)













2021 Biennial Bridge Inspection

- Letter of Concern
 - Significant Section Loss in Beams
- Overall Poor/Severe Condition
- Weight Limits Imposed
 - 27,000 lbs Single Unit
 - 40,000 lbs Combination Unit
- Inspection Cycle Every 3 months since 2021
 - (Last Inspection February 2025)





Total Costs over Life of Project:

Engineering: \$811,000

Construction: \$1,000,000

Total Costs Amended into FY 2025 TIP:

- FY 2025: \$231K Engineering (\$185K Federal, \$46K Local)
- FY 2025: \$1M Construction (100% Federally Funded IIJA)

Year of Operation – 2025 or 2026

This will depend on date construction awarded/duration.
